

NAME

`fc-scan` – scan font files or directories

SYNOPSIS

`fc-scan` [`-Vh`]

[[`-f format`] [`--format format`]] [`--version`] [`--help`] *file*...

DESCRIPTION

`fc-scan` scans *file(s)* recursively and prints out font pattern for each face found.

OPTIONS

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

`-f` Format output according to the format specifier *format*.

`-V` Show version of the program and exit.

`-h` Show summary of options.

file Scan *file* recursively for font faces.

RETURN CODES

`fc-scan` returns error code 0 if at least one font was found or 1 otherwise.
