## **DESCRIPTION**

leafpad is a simple GTK+ based text editor. The user interface is similar to Windows(tm) *notepad*. It aims to be lighter than GEdit and KWrite and to be as useful as them.

**WARNING:** The encoding feature is derived from built-in Glib's iconv feature (g\_convert), which you can check with command iconv -1. Leafpad can use only the listed encoding. Any other encoding cause serious data loss.
