

NAME

`cppw`, `cpgr` – copy with locking the given file to the password or group file

SYNOPSIS

`cppw` [-h] [-s] password_file

`cpgr` [-h] [-s] group_file

DESCRIPTION

`cppw` and `cpgr` will copy, with locking, the given file to `/etc/passwd` and `/etc/group`, respectively. With the `-s` flag, they will copy the shadow versions of those files, `/etc/shadow` and `/etc/gshadow`, respectively.

With the `-h` flag, the commands display a short help message and exit silently.
