select-default-wordlist - select default wordlist

SYNOPSIS

select-default-wordlist [options]

Options (all long only options):

| | |
|-------------------------------------|---|
| <code>--set-default='regexp'</code> | Try 'regexp' to get a single match and set it as default. Fail otherwise. |
| <code>--show-choices</code> | Show available choices to STDERR and exit. |
| <code>--debug</code> | Enable debug mode |

DESCRIPTION

This program is responsible for selecting default wordlist.

If `--show-choices` is used will just output a list of available choices to STDERR and exit. STDOUT cannot be used, this program loads **debconf** and **debconf** captures STDOUT.

If `--set-default` is used, program will try to get a single regexp match from available choices, failing if not. Will try case dependent match first, then case independent.

If `--set-default` is not used this program will make debconf always ask the shared question about the default wordlist to be used in your system according to the installed ones.

In both cases, will do the appropriate settings if needed.

Calls internally **update-default-wordlist**.
